

- Always make sure to fully tighten the bolts after attaching parts to the kit.






ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


1. Place the frame on the floor and swing the arms away from the center as shown. Insert the feet into the frame, adjusting to ensure the legs are all level on the floor. This will secure the frame and prevent it from falling over.




2. Tighten all the nuts with the included key. Tighten the knobs to secure the clamps to the bars. Assemble the two (2) cymbal clamps on the two (2) uprights as shown.




3. Install the cymbal rods into the sleeves on cymbal stands as shown. Use the included Philips screwdriver to tighten the set screw.



4. Install the cymbal + stand assemblies on the clamp stands.




5. Carefully fit the rod sleeves into the arm clamps. Insert the three (3) rods and one (1) L-rod through the corresponding rod sleeves into the arm clamps in the arrangement shown below.




6. Connect the tom pads and snare pad to the rods by aligning the holes on the side of each pad with the rod, then carefully sliding the rod through the holes. After attaching the pads, tighten the knobs underneath the pads to secure them in place.

Note: The tom pads belong on the regular rods, and the snare pad goes on the L-rod.




7. Remove the screws that come pre-installed in the kick pad. Align the holes on the kick brace with the holes on the kick pad as shown. Insert the four (4) screws you removed into the holes and use the Philips screwdriver to


tighten them.




8. Slide the kick brace into the kick. Lock down the plate on the kick, using the knob on the kick. This will raise the rocker arm and tighten the plate simultaneously. If you're using the kick on a carpeted surface, turn the anchor screws on both the plate and the pedal so that they extend into the carpet.




9. Remove the pre-installed screws from the sound module. Attach the module adapter to the bottom of the sound module using the four (4) screws you removed and a Philips screwdriver



10. Install the module adapter on the remaining clamp, then tighten the knob to secure it in place.



11. Insert the 25-pin connector from the wiring harness into the corresponding slot on the bottom of the sound module. Plug the audio jack connectors into the corresponding ports underneath each of the drum and cymbal pads. (Refer to the diagram below.) Use the self-fastening straps for effective cable management.
