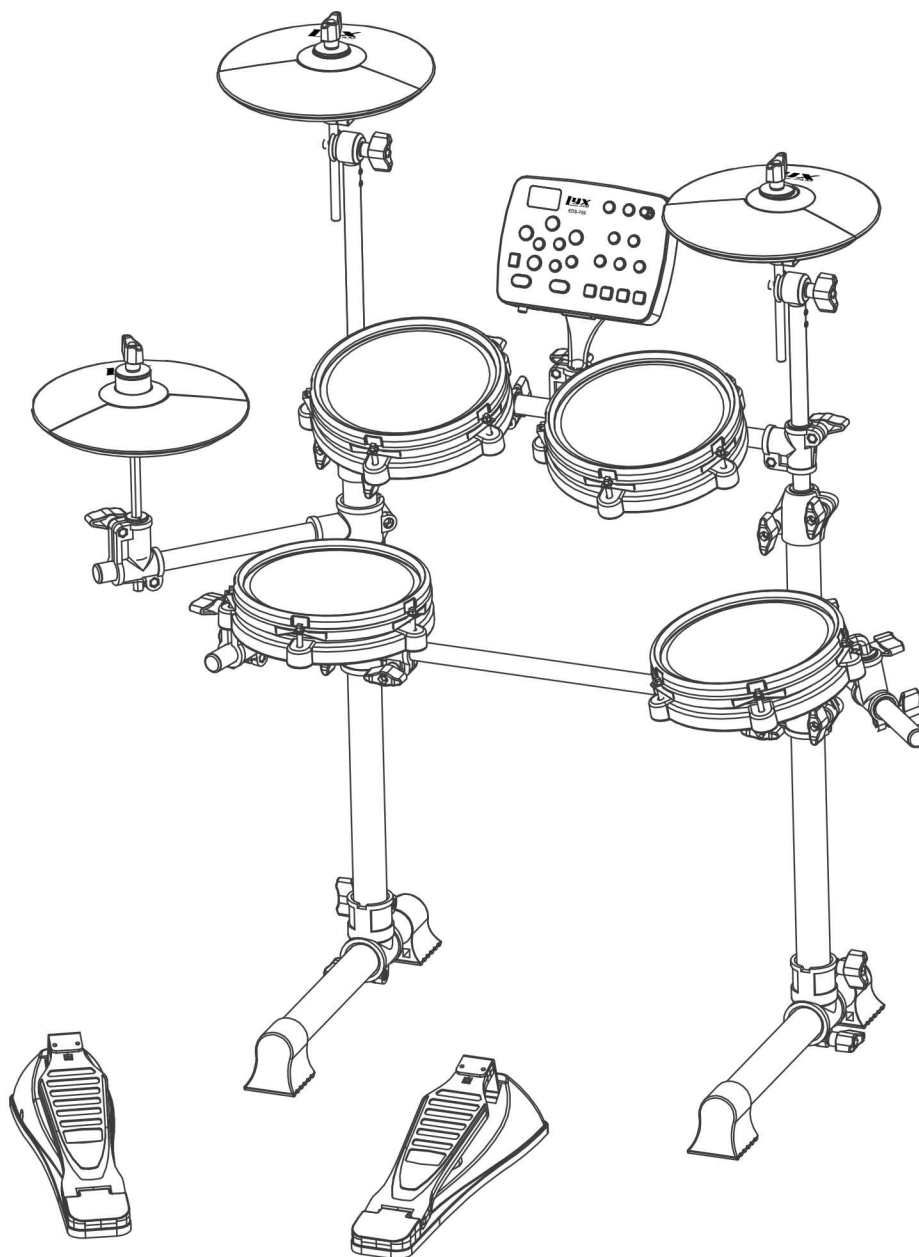

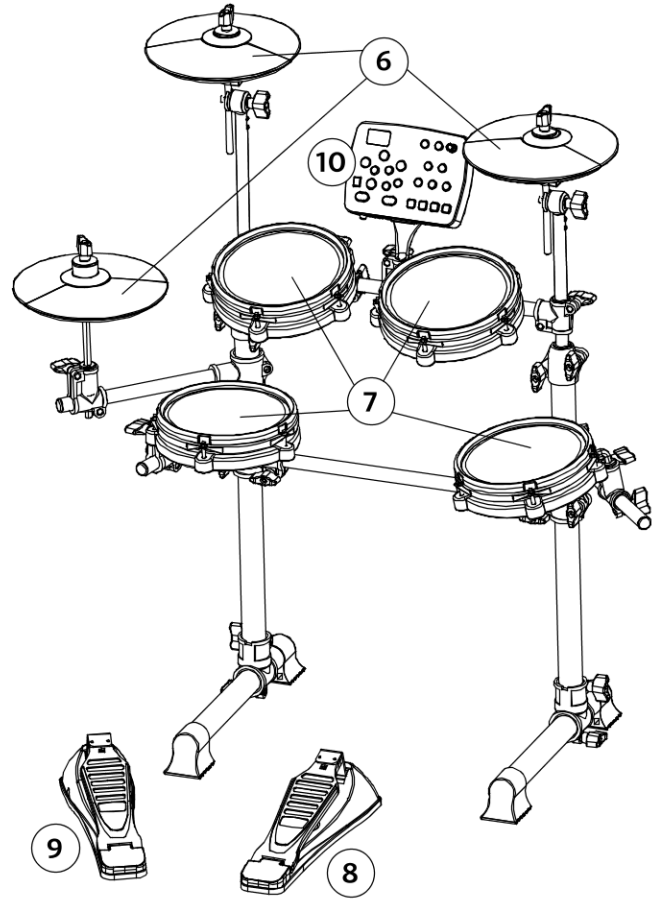
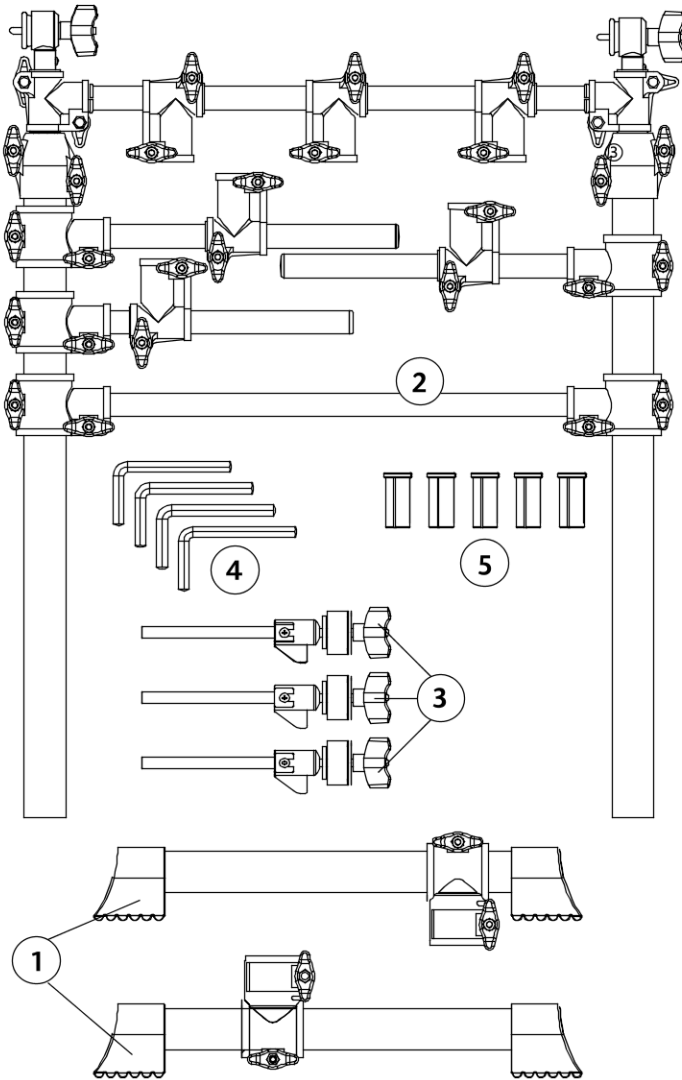
- Drum in a variety of environments: with headphones in your room, or connect to a sound system and play with a band.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

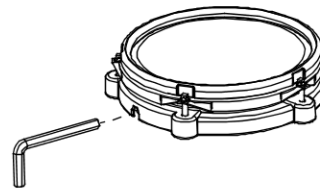
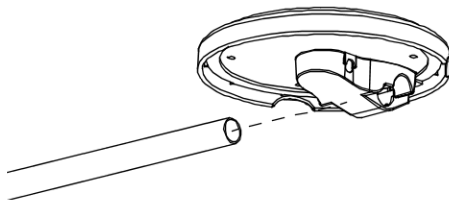
1. Place the feet on the floor and adjust the position of the clamps for the drum rack. Adjust the feet as needed to ensure the legs sit level on the floor.
2. Insert the frame into the slots on the feet. Place the frame on the floor and swing the arms away from the center.
3. Tighten the clamps to secure the frame to the feet.
4. Insert the rod sleeves into the clamps on the frame as shown in the diagram.
5. Insert two (2) of the cymbal rods into the clamps on top of the frame, and insert the third rod into the sleeve on the left arm as shown for the hi-hat cymbal pad. Tighten the wingnuts to secure the rods.
6. Insert the hex rods into their corresponding sleeves, then tighten the wingnuts to secure the rods to the frame.



7. Remove the wingnut, washer, and felt pad from the cymbal rods.
8. Attach the cymbal pad onto the rod, and then reinstall the felt pad, washer, and wingnut, in that order. Tighten the wingnut until the pad wobbles slightly to mimic a real cymbal.

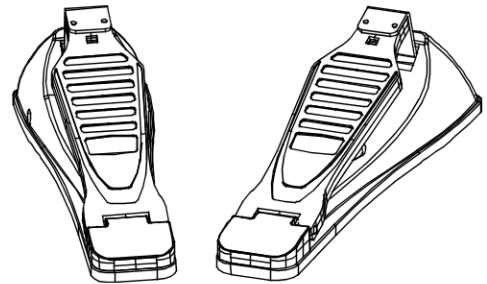


9. Connect the tom pads and snare pad to the rods by aligning the holes on the side of each pad with the rod, then carefully sliding the rod through the holes. After attaching the pads, tighten the knobs underneath to secure them in place.

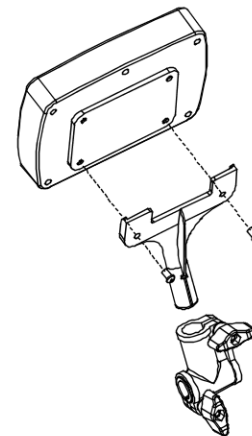


10. Place both pedals on the floor, with the pedal marked KICK on the right, and the hi-hat controller pedal on the left.

NOTE: To play the hi-hat with an open sound, strike the cymbal pad with a drumstick. To play it with a closed sound, depress the hi-hat controller pedal with your foot, then hit the pad with the drumstick. The two do not need to be physically connected to replicate this sound.



11. Remove the pre-installed screws from the sound module. Attach the module adapter to the bottom of the sound module using the four (4) screws you removed and a Philips screwdriver.
12. Install the module adapter on the remaining clamp, then tighten the knob to secure it in place.
13. Insert the 25-pin connector from the wiring harness into the corresponding slot on the bottom of the sound module. Plug the audio jack connectors into the corresponding ports underneath each of the drum and cymbal pads. Use the straps for efficient cable management.
