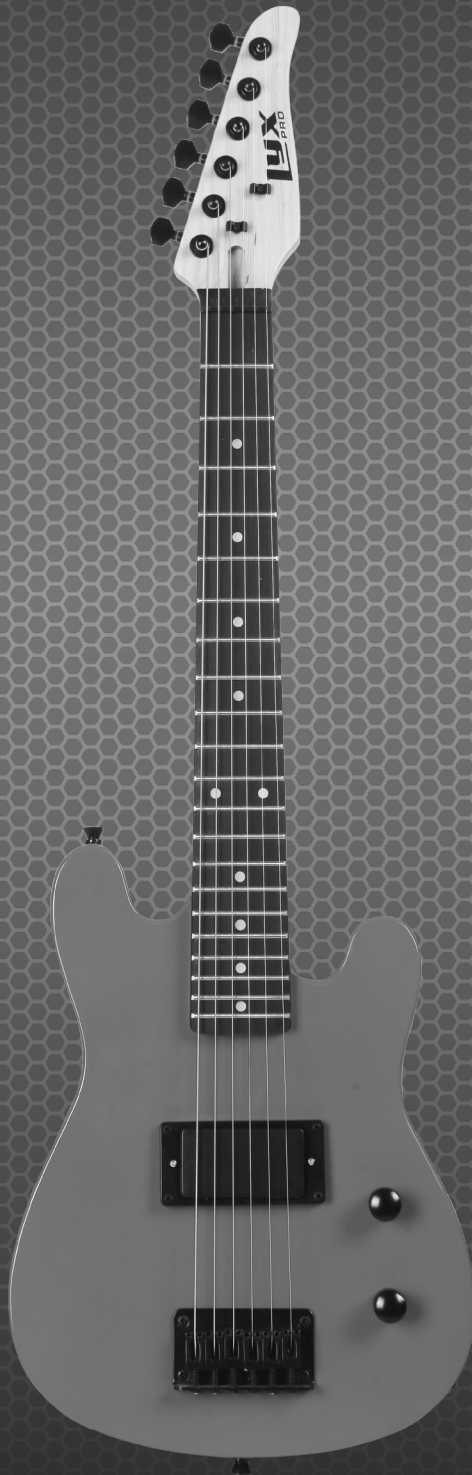

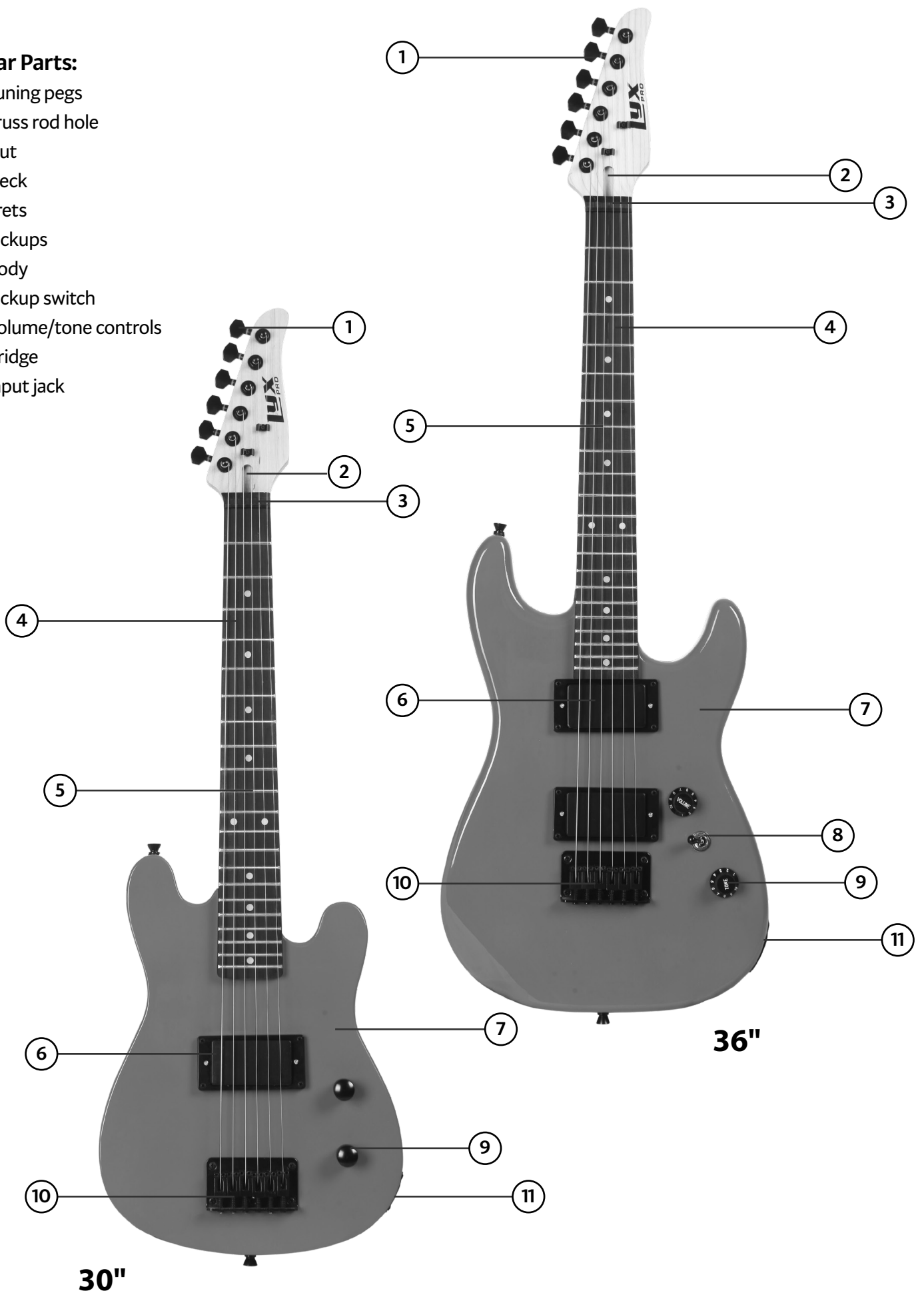

## Safety Precautions

- To avoid the risk of high voltage electric shock, do not attempt to open units.
- Do not attempt to repair units yourself; have them serviced by qualified personnel.
- Before connecting electrical equipment to the main power supply, make sure the outlet voltage corresponds to the voltage stated on the product's rating label.
- For all electrical products, align the plug properly and insert it fully. Do not overload the power outlet. If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or qualified personnel in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not expose these products, power cords and plugs to any type of liquid or moisture. Do not touch the power plug or the unit with wet hands.
- Switch off and unplug the guitar and amp when they are not in use.
- Do not store your products in places prone to high humidity, high temperature, dust, or static electricity.
- Do not drop the products.
- Do not use strong cleaners or solvents to clean these products.

## Tuning

Guitars have different headstock shapes, but the basic method to tune your instrument's strings is the same.

For easy tuning, see the section on your LyxPro Digital Mini Clip-On Instrument Tuner.

For manual tuning, you can use a tuning fork, electronic tuner, pitch pipe, or online tuner or app. Tune from a pitch below the correct pitch up to the correct pitch instead of down from a higher pitch. This eliminates slacking of strings and reduces the chance of strings going out of tune due to slippage as you play.

If you use an A-440 tuning fork or pitch pipe, start by tuning the second thickest string and move to the thinner one by one. After tuning the five strings, go back to the thickest string and tune the string. The following table shows standard tuning.

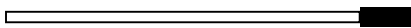

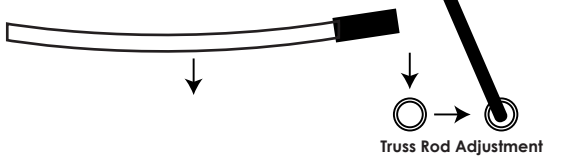
## Truss Rod Adjustment

Environmental conditions like temperature and humidity, as well as string tension, can cause bowing of the guitar neck. If your instrument has an adjustable truss rod, you can try to adjust it to keep the neck as straight as possible.

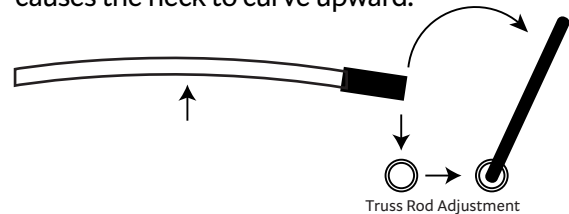
Truss rod in "flat" position



Tightening the truss rod counterclockwise causes the neck to curve downward.



Tightening the truss rod clockwise causes the neck to curve upward.



## Changing Strings

Replace one string at a time.

Unwind the old string at the tuning machine.

Remove the old string through the hole on the back of your guitar.

Insert a new string through the corresponding hole.

Run the string over the neck and the nut.

Feed the string through the hole in the tuning machine.

Bend the string around the post and wind the string using the tuning peg.

## Guitar Care and Maintenance

Keep your instrument in a case or carrying bag when transporting or storing it.

Do not place any objects on the top of your instrument.

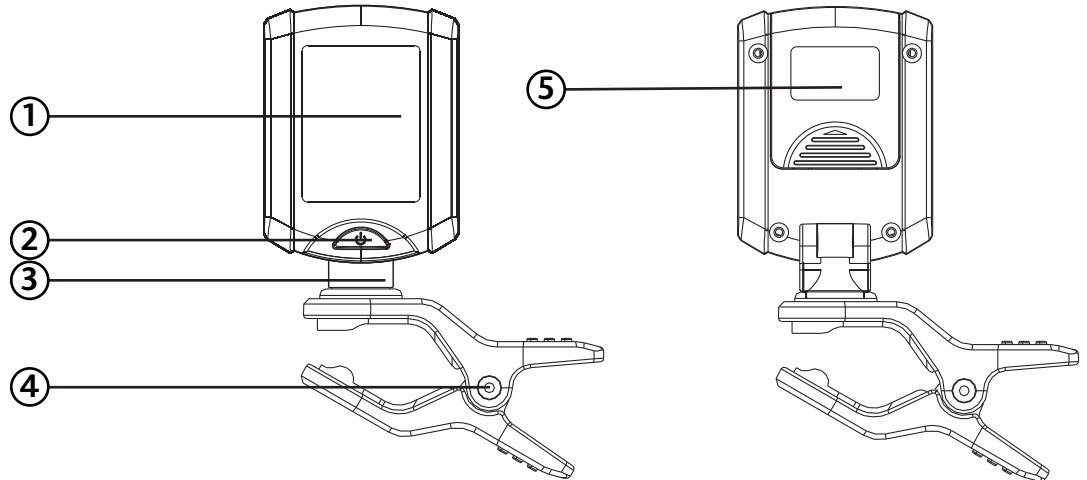
Regularly clean your guitar, including the finger board, with a clean, dry, soft cloth.

Polish the finished surface with an appropriate guitar polish.

Humidity and temperature affect your guitar. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures, high humidity, and excessively dry environments.

## Digital Mini Clip-On Tuner Parts:

1. LCD screen
2. Function button
3. Axis
4. Rotating clip
5. Battery compartment




## Inserting the Battery

Before using your new tuner, you must insert the battery included with the device.

1. Remove battery cover: Press the front of the battery cover and then slide it back.
2. Place the battery into the compartment with the negative (-) pole facing inward. Replace the cover and press down to lock it in place.
3. Once done, the tuner will be on and ready to use.
4. The tuner will power off after 3 minutes of inactivity.

## To Use

Tuner must be clipped onto your guitar to work.

Press the power button  to turn the unit on. Press and hold for 2 seconds to turn the unit off. The tuner will automatically power off after 3 minutes of inactivity.

Press once for each setting: (c) chromatic, (g) guitar, (b) bass, (v) violin and (u) ukulele.

When a string is plucked, the LCD screen will display whether the note is flat, sharp, or in tune. You can then tighten or slacken the string by turning the tuning peg to change the pitch until that string is in tune.

## Tuning your Guitar

1. Clip the tuner onto the headstock of your guitar and adjust for easy viewing.
2. Tune from the thickest string to the thinnest string.
3. Pluck the string and look at the digital readout. The LCD will display the name of the note. Look for one of three things:
  - a. Flat note: The indicator bar on the screen points left. Readout is white.
  - b. Sharp note: The indicator bar on the screen points right. Readout is white.
  - c. In tune: The indicator bar points straight up in the center of the screen. Readout is green.
4. If the note registers as sharp or flat, tighten or loosen the string to change the pitch until it is in tune.

## Amplifier Parts:

1. AUX input: Connect an audio source such as an MP3 player or mobile phone to play along with your recorded music.
2. Instrument input: Connect your guitar with the provided guitar cable.
3. Grind button: Turn on/off the gain control.
4. Gain: Adjust the amount of the amplifier gain.
5. Bass: Adjust the bass of the output.
6. Treble: Adjust the treble of the output.
7. Volume: Adjust the output volume.
8. Headphones: Connect headphones with a 1/4" TRS jack.
9. Power switch: Turn the amplifier on and off.
